Skidaway Road Path

Location: Chatham County, Georgia
Client: Chatham County Engineering
Type: Pedestrian & Bicycle Improvement
Funding: Local

Project Information:

- Design complete
- The project consists of a 0.7 mile, paved, multi-use path along Skidaway Road from the Sandfly Community to the Isle of Hope.
- The majority of the path is along a palm tree lined causeway across the marsh. Some of the palm trees will be relocated to accommodate the path. A prefabricated steel truss bridge is included in the project to cross a tidal tributary.
- A portion of the path crosses the historic property of Wormsloe Plantation. Extensive coordination with the Georgia Department of Natural Resources was required to minimize impacts to the property, as well as the coastal saltwater marshes. A subsurface stormwater system was included in the design beneath a swale adjacent to the path to avoid removal of trees and protect the visual attributes of the historic site.
