

Westside Parkway Phase III, Section 2

Project Information:

- Construction completed in 2008
- The project was a 0.7 mile long, new location, four-lane urban roadway with curb & gutter and sidewalks.
- Westside Parkway now provides a parallel, alternative route to the often congested SR 400 through Alpharetta.
- The alignment of Westside Parkway was set to avoid longitudinal encroachment to the 25' stream buffer of Tributary Number 5 of Big Haynes Creek, while minimizing impacts to the adjacent property.
- A FEMA No-Rise Certificate was prepared to document no effect on adjacent creek.
- Extensive coordination with developers of adjacent properties in order to minimize right of way costs.

Scope of Services:
